After medical school, **Dr. Olszewski** served in the Air Force as a flight surgeon for 13 years, came back to Kalispell and has served Montana families as an orthopedic surgeon for 20 years.

In 2014, **Dr. Olszewski** was elected to the Montana State Legislature as the Representative for House District 11 and then elected in 2016 to the Montana Senate District 6. State Senator **Dr. Olszewski** was a very busy senator and served on five committees: Public Health, Welfare & Safety; Agriculture; Finance & Claims; Rules; and the Joint Appropriations Subcommittee on Health & Human Services. In addition, he sponsored 13 bills, of which 10 passed. Although **Dr. Olszewski's** priority is to improve health and safety, he had the ability and productivity to sponsor and pass bills on voter fraud, medicaid overpayments, and taxes. Al is presently serving as a *Healthcare Policy Advisor* in Washington, D.C.

It may seem like **Dr. Olszewski** is all work and no play, but many families know him as a scout leader who enjoys Whitefish Mountain in the winter, white water rafting on the Middle Fork and hiking during the summer.


